Single Student Apartments for First-Year Transfer Students

UC Davis is pleased to offer first year Transfer Students an off campus apartment space leased through Student Housing. In addition to our residence hall spaces for transfer students, Student Housing is partnering with several apartment complexes within 1 mile of campus in the City of Davis. The two and three bedroom apartment spaces will be fully furnished with living and dining room furniture, bed, dresser, desk, task chair, lamp and waste basket. The apartments include utilities, high speed internet, cable, gas and electricity and full size kitchens.

The apartment complexes have Community rooms, BBQ areas, laundry facilities, and parking. Some of the properties offer a fitness center, swimming pool and game rooms.

The single student apartment space will have an optional meal plan available for convenient dining in any of our three campus Dining Commons. In addition to the amenities provided at these off campus apartments, all Student Housing Transfer Students are welcome to attend any residence hall program or seek assistance and/or advice from the professional staff within the Residential Education Office.
