## WASTE DIVERSION GUIDE

Residents are responsible for removing waste from their room. Here is a step-by-step guide on how to properly dispose of your waste and help UC Davis reach its goal of Zero Waste.



### Reusables

A collection bin for “Reusable” items can be found at the Segundo Area Service Desk.



### Mixed Recyclables

Empty your recyclables into the toter labeled “Mixed Recyclables” located on every floor in the laundry room.



### Cardboard

Cardboard boxes must be flattened and taken to the lobby and placed in the bin labeled “Cardboard” — boxes cannot be placed in chutes as they potentially will jam nor in the mixed recycling toters as they take up too much volume.



### Compost

Compost collection bins are located on every floor in the laundry room.



### eWaste

Items such as batteries, printer cartridges, and small electronics can be disposed of in a collection bin labeled “eWaste” that can be found at the Segundo Area Service Desk.



### Hazardous Waste

Used Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFL’s) can be exchanged at the Segundo Area Service Desk. If you have other hazardous waste to dispose of such as nail polish & remover, aerosol cans, expired pharmaceuticals, glue & adhesives, etc. call 530-752-2759 or email [sustainablehousing@ucdavis.edu](mailto:sustainablehousing@ucdavis.edu).



### Landfill

Waste that cannot be disposed of in any of the ways above will go into the Landfill chute located on every floor outside the lounges. Large items must be taken outside to the bins labeled “Landfill” located in the enclosures north of Ryerson & Malcolm, west of Gilmore, and northwest corner of Rienda.
