WASTE DIVERSION GUIDE

Residents are responsible for removing waste from their room. Here is a step-by-step guide on how to properly dispose of your waste and help UC Davis reach its goal of Zero Waste.



Reusables

A collection bin for “Reusable” items can be found near the Tercero Area Service Desk.



Mixed Recycling

Empty your recyclables into the recycling chute or toter labeled “Mixed Recyclables” located on every floor in the chute room .



Cardboard

Cardboard boxes must be flattened and taken to the first floor recycling/trash room to dispose in the “Mixed Recyclables” bin. Please do not put cardboard boxes down the chutes or in the “Mixed Recyclables” toters.



Compost

Compost collection bins are located on every floor in the chute rooms.



eWaste

Items such as batteries, printer cartridges, and small electronics can be disposed of in a collection bin labeled “eWaste” that can be found near the Tercero Area Service Desk.



Hazardous Waste

Used Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFL's) can be exchanged at the Tercero Area Service Desk. If you have other hazardous waste to dispose of such as nail polish & remover, aerosol cans, expired pharmaceuticals, glue & adhesives, etc. call 530-752-2759 or email sustainablehousing@ucdavis.edu.



Landfill

Waste that cannot be disposed of in any of the ways above are to go into the trash chutes located on every floor. Large items must be taken to the 1st floor recycling/trash room to dispose of in the bin labeled “Landfill”.
