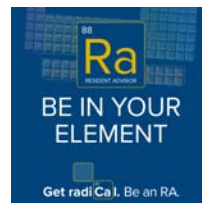

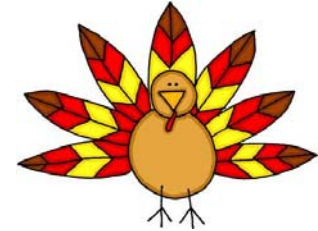

## Thanksgiving Break Meals

The dining commons (DCs) will close after dinner service on Wednesday, Nov. 23 and remain closed through Sunday, Nov. 27. Meal service will resume with breakfast on Monday, Nov. 28.

If you will be staying in the residence halls during the Thanksgiving break you can pre-order meals to enjoy while the DCs are closed.



### Meal Orders - Nov. 7 through Nov. 18

Meals can be ordered Nov. 7 through Nov. 18. The cost is one swipe per meal and meals must be paid for at the time of order. Unlimited meal plan holders must use Aggie Cash or cash to purchase the Thanksgiving break meals (\$10 after tax).

Meals can be ordered in any of the DCs or in the C-stores. Order forms will be located at the registers of the DCs and C-Stores. Meals must be picked up from the place that they are ordered between 9 a.m. and 7 p.m. on November 23.

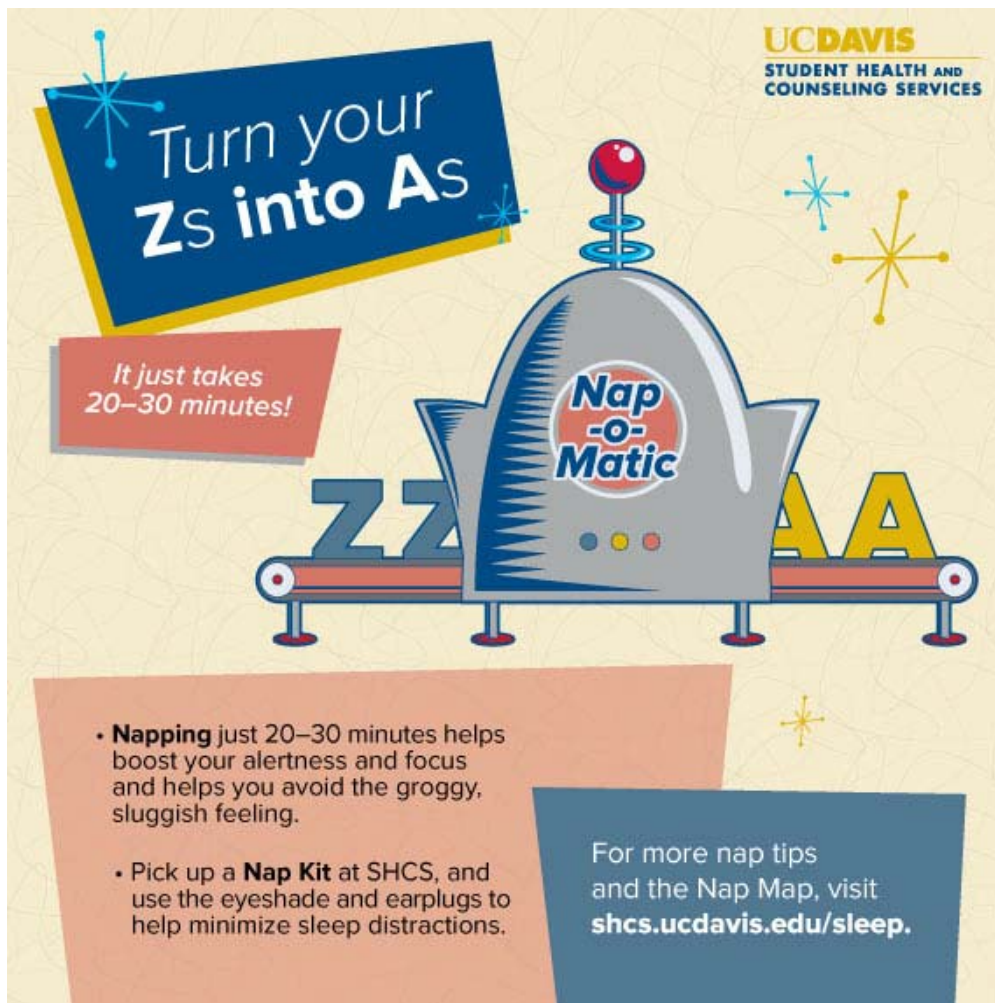
