

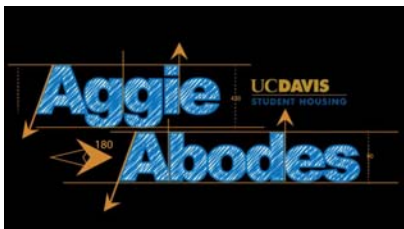

Do you have acne?

The UC Davis Department of Dermatology is looking for volunteers for a new acne research study.

- \* Do you have acne?

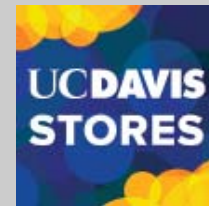


