

LICDAVIS CROSS CULTURAL CENTER WHAT IS CULTURAL APPROPRIATION? -Cultural appropriation involves taking an aspect of another community's culture: art, clothing designs, language, symbols, etc., without recognizing the historical context in which it came from. -Cultural appropriation might also involve stereotyping a community or identity in a way that harmfully impacts that community.

UCDAVIS CROSS CULTURAL CENTER TIPS TO AVOID APPROPRIATION: • RECOGNIZE HISTORY: Wearing costumes that have cultural value to marginalized communities ignores and invalidates their histories and the power dynamics at play. • FIGHT STEREOTYPES: Stereotyping a community can perpetuate harmful stigmas and notions that result in discrimination towards members of those communities. • KNOW WHO PROFITS: Many companies profit off of people's cultures while authentic products made by actual members of those communities go ignored and not supported.


